Shakespeare's *Unorthodox Biography* explodes the traditional attribution of the authorship of Shakespeare's plays. It proves that William Shakespeare from Stratford, unlike his literary contemporaries, left no contemporaneous evidence that he was a writer by profession. He was a theatrical entrepreneur and sharp businessman, but no literary genius.
